WORLD WORK PLACE SCHOLARSHIP

AWARD CRITERIA



The Mission Statement of the Chapter is to be an organization dedicated to developing the professional growth of our members through education, networking, certification and promotion of the Facility Management Profession.

In the promotion professional growth through education, one of the opportunities given to the members of the chapter through the scholarship program is to attend the annual World Work Place conference.

The scholarship varies from year to year but the base scholarship will award the winner full registration to attend World Work Place.

The scholarship is available under the following criteria:

- Financial solvency of the chapter will determine if a scholarship is to be awarded, how many scholarships and the contents or scope of the scholarship.
- The Chapter Member must attend at least three (3) meeting to be eligible for the scholarship.
- After the third meeting, an entry for the Chapter Member will be entered into a drawing for each meeting attended.
- Only Chapter Members that are in a current Facility position are eligible (base members and retired members are not eligible).
- Drawing for the Scholarship is held in conjunction with a monthly meeting and winner must be present to win.
- Scholarship is not transferable. If the winner is unable to attend then another drawing will be held.
- Scholarship winner from the previous two (2) years are not eligible.
- Chapter Members whose employer support IFMA and are financially able to send a Chapter Member to WWP are encouraged to withdraw their name from the drawing.
